ShutterBugs – Marko Ginsberg, Leader

Photography has always mirrored the technology of its time. Over the years we have moved from the bulky, heavy, glass plate using tripod mounted view cameras of the early years through various types of film camera systems to our modern digital system cameras.

So, what is it like to be a photographer in the digital age? Our cameras have lots of buttons, switches, wheels, dials, and menus. The number of choices is often overwhelming. And after we take our images, we are faced with some very capable but complex software to adjust them. Even printing our images presents us with more choices. What media should we use: paper, glass, canvas, wood, metal, or online digital?

HELP! I just want to take good pictures! Along comes ShutterBugs! The ShutterBugs activity group is all about digital photography in and around Evergreen. While we are having fun taking images, we are also improving our photographic skills. The group meets twice a month: on the first Friday for a photo shoot, and on the third Friday for sharing our images and discussing photography.

Our shoots are usually nature oriented; however, we are open to photographing anything the group finds interesting. During our first year of operation, in addition to nature photography, we had shoots focused on: outdoor sculptures, old buildings, old railroad equipment, and old farm equipment.

As we share our images the conversations center around the goal of the photographer in taking an image and kind suggestions for ways in which the image might be improved. Composition and point of view are common subjects; however sometimes we digress into discussions of what the impact on an image of the specific value chosen for a camera setting was.

We are a diverse group in skill levels and backgrounds and approach our art from many different perspectives. Our diversity is one of the key factors in how we learn from each other. It's great to see different approaches to the same subject.
